**AMENDMENTS TO CODE OF ORDINANCES**  
**HOURS OF OPERATION FOR A CASINO GAMING FACILITY**

Notice is hereby given that Public Hearings on proposed amendment to the Town’s Code of Ordinances are scheduled for a Tiverton Town Council Meeting:

Monday, August 26, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.  
Tiverton Town Hall, 343 Highland Road, Tiverton, RI.

**Code of Ordinances – Amendment Chapter 22 – Hours of Operation for a Casino Gaming Facility:** These amendments will amend Chapter 22 of the Code of Ordinances Section 22-11 and Section 22-11.1 - Hours of Operation for a Casino Gaming Facility within the Casino Gaming and Entertainment Overlay District-CGE. This ordinance will take effect upon passage.

This amendment makes the initial licensing statute, commonly referenced as a “PILOT” term, under which 24-hour operations of a gaming facility are currently permitted, an annual license subject to: annual renewal; an ongoing public safety protocol previously approved by the Town Council; and compliance with the Host Community Agreement for Operations between the Town of Tiverton and Twin River-Tiverton, LLC.

Anyone wishing to be heard on these proposed matters should be present at the aforementioned date and time. At the public hearing, opportunity shall be given to all persons interested to be heard upon the matter of the proposed amendments. The proposals may be altered or amended prior to the close of the public hearing without further advertising, as a result of further study or because of the views expressed at the public hearing.

All amendments shall take effect upon passage. Copies of the proposed amendment are available for public inspection in the office of the Town Clerk between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Mondays through Fridays and on the Tiverton website [www.tiverton.ri.gov](http://www.tiverton.ri.gov). The Town Hall is handicapped accessible. Persons requiring assistance should contact the Office of the Town Clerk at 625-6703 at least three business days prior to the hearing date.
