Sakonnet Bridge Bike Lane Celebration

On Saturday, APRIL 25th, enthusiastic bicyclists will be gathering to celebrate the 2015 biking season, and also the "LINK" that will one day tie two historic cities, colonial Newport, RI and the industrial revolution city of Fall River, MA in a future off-the-road bike path. The LINK that is already in place is the Sakonnet River Bridge Bike Lane, which now connects the towns of Portsmouth and Tiverton, RI.

Please join us in supporting the call for construction of bike paths within Tiverton and on Aquidneck Island. Connected paths that will serve you, the walkers, joggers, roller skaters/boarders, and bicyclists to enjoy and meet your needs for recreation, exercise, and commuting.

The gathering location is at the beginning of the bike lane entrance in Tiverton, at Evan Avenue. The gathering will take place at 1pm.
