


STONE BRIDGE REIMAGINED

WHAT? A charrette is an intensive planning session where citizens, designers, and others collaborate on a vision.

WHY? The charrette process will give East Bay citizens a voice in generating potential reuse options of the gas station structure, which abuts the Town-owned Grinnell's Beach. During the charrette, RWU students will present community members with potential development scenarios, gather constructive input from citizens, and re-develop options around the citizens' input. This process of re-developing scenarios based on the ideas of citizens insures that community interests are represented in the final Stone Bridge redevelopment scenario, which is to be presented to the Town of Tiverton in late July.
