Building Inspection Sequence

- 1. **Bottom** before stone/gravel (NOTHING IN THE BOTTOM)
- 2. Foundation after waterproof and/or insulation; before backfilling
- 3. Rough Electrical, Plumbing, Mechanical inspections
- 4. Rough Frame (Roofing & Siding included) Temporary stairs must be installed.
- 5. Insulation
- 6. The C.O. must be picked up at the office prior to calling in any Final inspection
- 7. Final Electrical, Plumbing, Mechanical
- 8. Final Wastewater/Sewer Certificate
- 9. Well water test done by a RI Certified Company
- 10. Final Assessor's approval (call 625-6709 for appt) Home should be in move in condition.
- 11. Final Fire Department Inspection (Call Fire Dept directly for appointment 625-6707)
- 12. Final Building and/or Certificate of Occupancy.

Nothing is allowed to be stored in the home prior to a Certificate of Occupancy being issued other than materials for the project. You will be asked to remove any other items (eg. Furniture, boxes, etc.) and will be charged with a re-inspection fee of \$90.00.

If you do not receive or fail an inspection, you may not proceed unless directed to do so by the Inspector. In accordance with R109.4 RISBC-2

401-625-6715 Code Enforcement Office; you may leave inspection information on the answering machine.

Inspection Regulations

- 1. Twenty four (24) hours notice must be given for each inspection
- 2. If there is a contractor on the permit he/she must call in their own inspection(s).
- 3. The following information must be given in order to receive an inspection:
 - a. Street location or lot # and street name; please note that the location must be marked clearly.
 - b. Type of inspection that is being requested.
 - c. Permit number; located at the top right of your permit.
 - d. Name and phone number for contact in case of a problem or status.
 - e. Location of open door or key if no one will be there for the inspection.

Reinspection Fees

When an inspection is requested and the work is <u>not ready</u>, the <u>premises is locked</u> or <u>not accessible</u> <u>by means of a set of stairs</u> or is <u>not approved</u>; a re-inspection fee of \$90.00 will be charged to the installer (homeowner or contractor) and is due prior to any re-inspection by any town inspector.
